Quality is paramount ...from the selection of the finest raw materials, to the final evaluation and approval by quality control personnel with final evaluation and approval by the world's foremost artists. Pianos considered as NEW are pianos that have never been sold via a retail store to the public and with build dates within 1 year of the current date. KeyArts Piano of Houston warrants your piano to be free from defects of workmanship and materials during the warranty period of:

Ten (10) Year (s) from the date of purchase. This warranty is transferable.

This warranty does not apply to routine maintenance, tuning, regulation and voicing. Furthermore, this warranty does not apply if defects are due to the following:

- 1. Accidental damage.
- 2. Abuse, modifications, negligence, or use in extreme climate conditions - i.e. temperature and humidity extremes
- 3. The piano's serial number has been removed, altered or defaced.

Upon discovery of a defect, contact KeyArts if said defect is the direct result of defective workmanship or materials. We will repair such defect within a reasonable period of time without charge. If a defect cannot be repaired or is not cost effective to do so, we will replace the piano with a similar instrument. Prior authorization by KeyArts is required for any repair or replacement under this warranty. In the event that your piano shall prove defective in workmanship or materials, your remedy shall be the repair or replacement if necessary, as stated under this warranty. Under no circumstances shall KeyArts be liable for any loss or damage, direct, incidental or consequential, arising out of the use of or inability to use this piano. Please keep in mind that pre-owned, factory restored or conditioned pianos are not considered "New" but are termed "Near New" and could have very minor cosmetic defects which will not materially affect the performance of or the value of the instrument. This warranty is in lieu of all other warranties, statements or representation and unless stated herein, are void unless provided otherwise by state law. Pianos used, stored or purchased for use in extreme climates with prolonged high or extremely low average humidity percentages and or temperatures during the year, must be protected by appropriate and approved equipment to maintain humidity and temperature within normal ranges. Normal temperature ranges are ideal at 72 F. Humidity ideals are 42%. In practical use pianos do not function well in extremely high or low humidity and temps. Placement of pianos in tropical or desert environments where extremes are common are not recommended unless proper controls are in place. See KeyArts Humidity & Temp guides on the website. Warranty claims do not cover damage by improper transportation or by other than certified, professional piano movers. When transporting your piano verify insurance and certification of your mover.
